"Now that we've past Memorial Day and are into the month of June, the summer season is upon us, and ..."

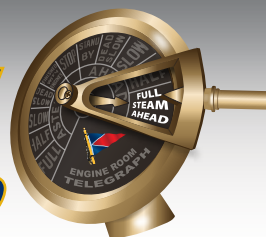
Who are we kidding? We live in Southwest Florida! It's summer all year long! Even in winter, it's still pretty much like summer. Well, pretty much like a mid-west summer, anyway. What June does bring to us is the beginning of the hurricane season. I didn't want to say it, but I had to say it ... the VYC is susceptible to hurricanes. But, going forward, we will be somewhat less so. Thanks to the diligent and professional work of both our Emergency Preparations Committee, headed by our fellow member Brian Kemp, and with the support of our General Manager Ed Tindall, the VYC is much better prepared for whatever Mother Nature may throw at us. You may have noticed the mild construction along the first floor exterior doors and windows. This recent work is part of the infrastructure needed to support the new flood barrier system that the Club has purchased. The system is designed to allow us to install a waterproof barrier along the outside of the Club to help mitigate (notice I didn't say "eliminate") water intrusion into the main Clubhouse. This system, along with a whole series of other planned weather defense actions, will put the VYC in the best position to ride out a storm, with the goal of minimizing expensive damage, and facilitating a quicker recovery and reopening of our facilities.

The Emergency Preparation Committee is just one example of the "behind the scenes" activities that take place at the VYC, both member committee driven, and management driven, which support the continued functions here at the Club. So the next time you see Brian Kemp, thank him for leading the EPC, and hope that, like our homeowner's insurance, the committee's planning efforts go largely unused this storm season.

Venice Yacht Club Charitable Foundation

Dear Fellow Club Members:

This Spring saw grant checks given to several local organizations, including Neuro Challenge Foundation, Our Mother's House, and our first-ever grant to the Mote Marine Laboratory. The \$5,000 donation will be used for a youth science program in the new facility's state-of-the-art laboratory (more to come on this initiative in an upcoming column). The 2nd cycle of our grant process just concluded, and 14 recipients will receive grants. Results will be reported in the next column in the July/August Currents.

Dogs, Inc. is a longtime VYCCF fave! In an old farmhouse on an orange grove in Palmetto, FL, this effort started in 1984 as a collaboration between a local ophthalmologist and the Lions Club. They recognized a need for local guide dog training. "All the dog schools were up north at that time," explains Katie McCoy, the Director of Philanthropy. "It's hard to train dogs in the north and ship them here to work in the heat," she says. Since its inception, the group has placed dogs in 48 States, but all the recipients come here to get their dogs and receive training. For actual guide dogs the training time is 3 weeks and the students stay in dormitories on the spacious campus.

120 dogs are placed in an average year, and they all perform different types of service. From actual guide dogs for the visually impaired to companion dogs for children with disabilities to veterans with PTSD and Gold Star Families experiencing grief, these dogs are literally a lifeline to a fuller and more independent way of living. "My guide dog has changed my life," says McCoy, who herself is visually impaired. "She enables me to go out to concerts, to Disney; I even went hiking out West," she says.

McCoy urges any Club member with questions to reach out; there are public tours of the impressive facility and even an immersive program, "Beyond the Dark," in which one can experience just how helpful these wonderful canines can be with a visually impaired human! There are myriad ways to get involved as Dogs, Inc. relies on volunteer host families for the puppies

(all are bred right here in SW Florida) the first 18-24 months years of their lives. Call 941-529-5665 for more information or check out DogsInc.org.

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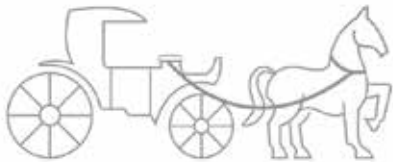
